Your student is enrolled in the General Financial Literacy course required for Utah high school graduation. The standards for this course include:

- Financial Goals and Planning
- Income and Career Planning
- Money Management
- Saving, Investing, and Retirement
- Consumer Safeguards and Risk Management

A key ingredient for a child's successful learning is parental/guardian involvement. Research shows that students learn a considerable amount of their financial knowledge and habits from their parents/guardians. Parental involvement with the assignments and activities in this course will increase student understanding and help them grow to be independent, self-supporting individuals who make responsible, informed decisions.

Protecting student/family privacy and identity is essential. Consistent with Utah Law, Section 53A-13-301, students will NOT be asked to provide any personal/family information of financial data.

However, to make the course concepts meaningful to the students, they may be asked to develop individual financial plans or budgets or to otherwise make a personal application of financial principles. For example, with parent/guardian permission or assistance, a student may gather and analyze information about buying a car of his/her choice, set up an ongoing personal budget, or identify a spending plan for the prom or other event.
